

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township of Lehman that it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION I:

This ordinance shall hereafter be referred to as the "Snow and Ice Ordinance".

SECTION II:

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, owning or occupying any property abutting or bordering upon any street, road, or highway of Lehman Township to deposit, throw or shovel or to cause to allow or permit any person or persons to deposit, throw or shovel, any snow or ice in and upon the travel portion of any such street, road or highway.

SECTION III:

The owner of any vehicle or person in whose name it is registered shall not allow, permit or suffer such vehicle to stand or park, in any street, way, road, highway or parkway under the control of Lehman Township in such a manner as to interfere with the work of removing or plowing snow or removing ice.

SECTION IV:

For the purpose of removing or plowing snow or ice from any public way in the Township of Lehman, the Lehman Township Police may remove or cause to be removed any vehicle parked in such a manner as to interfere with such work referred to in the preceding sections. The cost of such removal and storage charges to be born by the owner of the vehicle.

SECTION V:

Any person or persons, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof, in a summary proceeding, before a District Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$600.00 and costs, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, be imprisoned in the County Jail for a period not exceeding 90 days. Each and every day upon which any person or persons, firm or corporation, violates or continues to violate the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION VI:



All other ordinances inconsistent herein are hereby repealed. The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any of its provisions or exceptions shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, the decision of the Court shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provisions or exceptions had not been included herein.

SECTION VII:

The Lehman Township Supervisors find this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and public safety.
